SUBMISSION TERMS + CONDITIONS

- > **Submissions should be received no later than March 28, 2025**
- > **Projects completed within 2023/2024 will be accepted**, provided they have not been previously submitted
- > Unlimited submissions per category, the first submission is free. Each additional submission will be charged \$50 to cover the cost of the professional poster that is displayed at the Awards Gala. The poster(s) belong to the manufacturer and can be taken at the end of the evening
- > Professional quality digital photos must be submitted, if you need professional photos we recommend Sergei Belski: photo@sergeibelski.com
- > Only projects manufactured by AWMAC Manufacturer Members are eligible
- > The Association reserves the right to re-define the category for which a project is submitted or combine categories of work where the volume of submissions warrants
- > All submissions will be evaluated but not all entries may be selected for final judging
- > The Association reserves the sole right to refrain from displaying work or giving an award if the project(s) submitted do not meet the Associations standards of quality
- > All files submitted become the property of the Association and the completed submission form grants the Association the right to display the work. Credit will always be provided when the work is displayed or incorporated in Association materials.
